The Seeds of Change Society

The Seeds of Change Society is a giving circle by friends and supporters of BCM Georgia, formerly known as Buckhead Christian Ministries, established to respond to working Georgians facing eviction and providing tools and resources for their economic empowerment. Since 2011, like minded women gather to fellowship, raise awareness, and funds to support the mother's, children, and households through an annual luncheon and other social events.

Support Life Changing Programs

BCM Georgia has been serving the community since 1987. Built upon the collaborative idea developed by a small group of founding churches, the organization began to serve the local community by assisting our most vulnerable neighbors. As the years have passed, BCM Georgia has grown and become one of the most stable and reliable resources for individuals and families facing housing insecurity. Today, BCM operates three main programs: Emergency Housing Assistance, Budget for Life, and Foundation 3.

Budget for Life – households build the skills, knowledge, and habits to become financially stable and make better economic decisions. Participants attend case management, financial coaching sessions, and financial education classes. This program began in 2005. In FY25, 50 households will enroll in each cohort, with significant debt reduction and establishment of savings by each family.

Foundation 3 – working families who are unhoused can achieve stability through housing, employment, and educational support from BCM's professional team of case managers. 15 families are enrolled in this 12-18 month program at any given time and are able to considerably improve their rental history, reduce debt, learn how to budget, and achieve educational and certification goals.

Emergency Housing Assistance (EA) – assists families who are facing a crisis with support toward housing related bills. This program allows families to work through their challenges and remain in their home instead of becoming homeless. More than 1,000 households on the brink of eviction will be served through this program this year. *Research shows that 90% of clients will remain housed following this supportive intervention*.

The Seeds of Change Society started the Extra Wish in 2023 for Budget for Life and Foundation 3 Programs. Our participants are making progress in these 12, up to 18 month, programs, reducing debts, learning how to and actively budgeting. Extra Wish grants cover needs that families have to put them on more solid footing. This prepares them for when they graduate from our programs and continue to thrive on their own.

Cost of Poverty Experience Benefit

Sponsors at the Cherokee and Magnolia Level receive the Cost of Poverty Experience Private Event. This event is a 2.5 hour immersive experience where participants navigate the roles, responsibilities, and challenges of families navigating poverty. Participants learn about the obstacles facing our community, engage with the experiences of real families, and build empathy for our neighbors. The event can host 20-120 participants.
